- Provide oversight of prescribed medication, performs mental health assessments, develops and presents clear clinical impressions and recommendations that are specific and attainable. Develops and documents clear clinical formulations.
- Must be knowledgeable of psychopathology and other behavioral health concerns. Be able to triage clinical emergencies and implement safety and consultation protocols. Utilizes best practices and evidenced based practices and adheres to program expectations.
- Must communicate professionally with all clients, families, and collaborating professionals.

Qualifications:

- Registered Nursing degree and a Master of Science in Nursing plus 2 years relevant work experience. Board certified as an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse as appropriate for the population served by the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners or American Nurses Credentialing Center is required.
