As identified, provides hands-on instruction with activities of daily living and life-skill coaching as required. Reports to the Director of South Central Peer Services. Performs other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements: High school diploma or equivalent required with a minimum of six (6) months' experience in a related behavioral health field. Consideration will be given with no experience if candidate possesses a CT Recovery University Certification. Valid Connecticut Driver's license with clean driving record is required and must be maintained. First Aid/CPR certification or willingness to obtain certification within 90 days of hire. Employee is responsible to maintain ongoing certification. Proficient computer skills required, including Microsoft Office and electronic record keeping.
